## Steps You Can Take To Introduce a New Cat

- 1. Enhance the environment
  - a. See "Enhancing Your Indoor Cat's Environment"
- 2. Isolate the new cat in a room with food, water and a litter box.
- 3. Exchange blankets so the cats get used to each other's smell.
- 4. Call the resident cat to the door of the isolation room for a special treat, to try to build a positive association (i.e. new cat= special treat)
- 5. Isolate the resident cat and let the new cat out to explore the house. Then isolate the new cat again.
- 6. Let the two cats out together for a special treat. Then isolate the new cat again.
- 7. Behavior of the cats will dictate how long this process takes.
